

VISIT TO CSMVS

On 5th September 2023, we all S.Y.B.Ed students were send to the Visit of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangrahalaya (was earlier known as Prince of Wales Museum). It is located at Churchgate (Mumbai). The building of the museum has three floors. The 3rd floor is Dome shaped having a feature of Taj Mahal. The 2nd & 1st floor is made of wood outlook like Maratha Empire and the Ground floor has a picture fountain in the centre. The museum has various galleries firstly on the Ground floor. Dajali ma'am gave us an introductory lecture about the museum and then we were told to go the children's museum, which is at the corner of the building. The children's museum is build only 4 years back, it has many arts and pictures giving students visited there for past 3 years. The museum also has a facility of museum on wheels for those children who cannot come to the museum. In the children's museum, Megan ma'am gave us an introduction on the museum and the main functions of it working for the education department. She gave us 3 techniques for teaching, which can be practiced which teaching learning process. The first technique was Hot Seating technique. In which a teacher can behave like any object & ask the students to question about the object and answer the question. The second technique was Description challenge in which the teacher can ask the students to look at the objects and answer the question, and the third technique was Connection between object & the students.

Exhibits in the children's museum was very nice which were given by some children for example; The Statue of Lord Ganesha, the Pair of Cymbals; The different types of Spoons of different shapes & sizes. The tree outside the children's museum is 101 year old. The Ground floor of the main museum has different stones of Lord Ganesha, Buddha and Krishna, Shiva. There are various Galleries in the museum related to Art, History and Natural History, Heritage. There were the Sculpture gallery, the Pre and Post Proto history gallery and Natural History gallery, Indian Miniature Painting gallery, Krishna gallery, Himalayan Art gallery, Decorative Metalware gallery, House of Laxmi - Coin Gallery, Karl and Meherbai Khandvala gallery, Chinese and Japanese Art gallery, Sir Ratan Tata and Sir Dorab Tata gallery of European Paintings. Arms and Armour gallery, Jehangir Nicholas gallery, Premchand Roychand gallery, first floor circle gallery, Second floor circle gallery, European Decorative Art gallery, Bombay School gallery, Textile Gallery, Prints gallery. All these galleries show & depict very important instructions. The first floor galleries showed many pictures of ancient history. I specially
